

Examining Our Giving in 2012

Luke 6:38 What challenge is the Lord giving to the believer in this passage? Are you responding in faith when you give?

I Timothy 6:16 What admonition is given to the one who has money? What responsibility is expected from the one who has been financially blessed?

Proverbs 11:25 What does wisdom say is the way to be increased financially?

James 2:15, 16 What is the responsibility of the Church to its members in terms of giving?

Matthew 6:28-33 If you struggle in your personal finances, what solution does the Lord present? What adjustments do you need to make? Is your checking account sending you a message?

Phillipians 4:14-19 What does Paul call the financial gift the Philippian church gave? Is your job or your checkbook the source for financial provision? What is?

Proverbs 3:9, 10 In the book of wisdom, what is the "secret" to supernatural provision? Are you following this principle? What would that look like in your life?

Malachi 3:8-11 How does God view a failure to tithe? What challenge does God give us as we tithe? Can you think of another place in scripture where believers are encouraged to test the Lord?

Deuteronomy 26:12-14 What does this passage call the tithe? How might you eat your tithe in a time of mourning or loss? Is this a danger in your life?

Matthew 6:2-4 Is giving optional for the believer? Is giving a dead end? In other words, how will God respond to your giving?

Proverbs 19:17 When you write out a check to a Christian relief agency, how does God see it?

Matthew 25:34-46 How does God view our giving to the neediest among us? Are we responsible for this segment of society?

Acts 11:27-30 If we follow this example, how should our giving closely follow the spiritual gifts?

Proverbs 21:13 What is an effective way to shut down your prayer life and get your back against the wall with God?

II Corinthians 9:6-11 Is it God's will for you to barely get by financially? What is the purpose of Godly provision financially? What does the word "all" mean in this passage?

Deuteronomy 28:1-14 Has this promise (like the promise of speaking in tongues and other gifts of the Spirit) "passed away" in this dispensation? We know that speaking in tongues will not happen for the Christian who does not believe that promise. Do you believe the Deuteronomy 28 promise? What are the prerequisites for these blessings?
